The L.A. area has the highest concentration of officially Apple-registered and recognized Macintosh User Groups anywhere. We're more than 1/3 of all the groups in California, and more groups than any other state.

Our 40 groups span 11 different area codes, date back to April 1976, have membership dues of nothing on up to \$60 per year, have memberships of 10 to 400 people and monthly attendance of 10 to 250 people. Over 6,600 people are members of L.A. area Mac User Groups, and over 1,600 attend an L.A. area MUG meeting each month.

The L.A. area also has the highest concentration of Apple Stores, 6 in a 35 mile radius. There is no correlation between user groups and Apple Stores, but it is moderately interesting to see their ratio per state. —>
